

## **Marilyn Peschong Memorial Scholarship Application**

In order to promote Catholic education in the city of Mitchell, the Peschong family established the Marilyn Peschong Memorial Scholarship in 2011. This one-time \$1,000.00 scholarship is available for a graduating senior of Mitchell High School or Mitchell Christian School who has:

- 1. Attended St. John Paul II Catholic School for a minimum of three years
- 2. Graduated 6<sup>th</sup> grade from John Paul II School and
- 3. Will be continuing their education at an accredited college, technical school or university in the fall of 2024.

The candidate must show active involvement in the Catholic Church, complete the entire Mitchell Community Scholarship Form and include it with the attached application. The deadline for returning all application materials to the St. John Paul II School Office will be April 15, 2024 or postmarked by April 15, 2024. The candidate must also complete an essay (min. 200 words) titled "How Catholic Education Has Made a Difference in My Life.

The winner will be chosen based on these factors in no particular order:

- 1. Financial Need (be sure to note in the Mitchell Community Scholarship application)
- 2. Church Involvement
- 3. Essay
- 4. Moral Character
- 5. Scholastic Integrity
- The winner will be announced in May.
- The award will be remitted directly to the educational institution, after a semester of school has been completed and proof of continuing education exists.
